- 3. Offer an invitation to receive Christ.
- 4. Challenge the congregation to share the tract with one person before the following Sunday.
- 5. On the following Sunday, ask for testimonies from those who shared the tract.

This is a wonderful way to train folks to share the faith. It not only will bless the community but will bring joy to the congregation as they are obedient to the Lord in sharing their faith.
