Creative ideas to help you reach your community for Christ

- New Year's Eve Watch Night Service Host a late-night worship service catered to a crowd willing to stay up...youth, 20-somethings, etc. and encourage them to invite friends. Use the service as a time to praise God for His blessing over the past year, repent and reaffirm a commitment to Him while praying for the year ahead. Then provide a midnight snack or early break-fast...pancakes, doughnuts or even a waffle bar. Remember, register everyone and be sure to follow-up.
- Free Gift Wrapping Have your Sunday School Class wrap presents at Walmart (or another business) free of charge during the Christmas season. Things to remember: Get permission from the store, provide all of the supplies, do a good job (you are representing our Lord as well as your church), NEVER...EVER...CHARGE!!!, give out brochures and invite each customer to your church services.
- Do a living nativity outside and invite the community to come and see it.
- Offer a free meal on Christmas Eve before your church service and invite the community.
- Give away transparent tape and wrapping paper.
- Have your worship band play in front of a store (make sure they have rehearsed well prior and have permission to be there).
