Tabernacle is inviting and promoting their sister churches in close proximity to their block party because they are focused on Christ's kingdom and not their own. They have another party planned within the next two months.
- Thirteen people who were lost and under the wrath of God in February have entered into a right relationship with God in Christ through revival services at Higgston Baptist.
- B.L. Horne shared with me the extraordinary story of the inception and genesis of The Cleft, a shelter for teenage girls in need of compassion and care.
- First Alamo's build team built a temporary wheelchair ramp at Freedom House for the new house manager, John Boatwright. Freedom House, a new ministry to which our Association is giving birth, is now beginning to stand-up and will soon take its first steps.
