State Capitol Building

First Floor

Room 132 - Judiciary Committee Room

Pray that the House chairman of this committee would provide moral and Godly leadership as he/she selects the bills to be heard in committee.

Press Conference Area(s)

Pray that truth would be spoken from this place and the press area on the 3rd floor and that God would have influence over what the press announces.

Second Floor

The second floor is the Executive floor and houses the offices of Governor Nathan Deal, Lt. Governor Casey Cagle and Secretary of State Brian Kemp.

- Pray for Gov. Deal, Lt. Gov. Cagle and Secretary Brian Kemp that the Spirit of God would move over them in a mighty way.
 - Pray that they would know the truth of God's Word and look to the Lord as they make decisions.
 - Pray that they will take a principled stand on important, moral issues and lead the General Assembly to do the same.
 - Pray that they will not be afraid to get on their face before God even as our Founding Fathers did.
 - Pray for the protection of Georgia history and restoration of our Godly heritage across the state.
- Pray for the protection, salvation and spiritual maturity of State leaders and their families.
 - Pray that the Lord would bring prayer warriors and intercessors onto the Governor's staff.
 - Pray that the Spirit of God would move over everyone who enters this place.

Second Floor (continued)

- Pray that Christians would be elected, appointed and called to the positions of authority in this building
 - Pray that Christians throughout our state government would be bold, influential and Spirit led.
 - Pray that they would possess Godly wisdom and use that wisdom in all the decisions they must make.
 - Pray for the upcoming State-wide elections, that a Godly men and women would be elected who are bold, fierce about religious liberty and fervent lovers of Christ.

Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, [and] giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. I Timothy 2:1-2

Third Floor

The third floor is known as the legislative floor and it is where our legislators gain access to both the House and Senate chambers. It also houses the offices of President Pro Tempore David Shafer and Speaker of the House David Ralston.

- Pray that the Georgia Legislature would legislate righteously as they remain faithful to the guidelines of the Georgia Constitution.
- Pray that things done in darkness would be brought to light.
- Pray that the Spirit of God would move in a mighty way over this place.
- Pray that righteous House and Senate members would move and speak with great boldness against darkness.

When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice; But when a wicked [man] rules, the people groan. Proverbs 29:2

Fourth Floor

The fourth floor houses the offices of the majority and minority leaders, in addition to a museum. It also provides access to the House and Senate galleries. Citizens are allowed to sit in the galleries and watch the business of the legislature. It is a great place to pray during the legislative session.

- Pray that Christians would be appointed to the positions of authority in this building.
- Pray that they would possess Godly wisdom and use that wisdom in all the decisions they must make.
- Pray that men and women will be faithful to be involved in the legislative process.
- Pray that churches will step up and be the salt and light that they should be in their communities.

Judicial Building – Office of State Attorney General Chris Carr

- Pray for Attorney General Chris Carr and his position.
- > Pray for health and safety for Mr. Carr and his family.
- Pray that ethical and moral standards are used to interpret Georgia's Constitution as it applies to her modern laws.

Coverdell Legislative Office Building (CLOB)

The Legislative Office Building houses committee hearing rooms and offices of the majority of the Georgia House and Senate members. The building is named Paul D. Coverdell Legislative Office Building after the late Sen. Paul Coverdell.

CLOB (continued)

Committee Hearing Room 310: Senate Regulated Industries and Utilities Committee hearing room. Typically bills discussed in this room concern topics such as alcohol or gambling.

- Pray that the chairman of this committee would provide moral and Godly leadership as he/she selects the bills to be heard in committee.
- > Pray for those working in the Legislative Office Building.
 - Pray that Christians would be appointed to positions of authority in these buildings.
 - Pray that the Christians who work in these buildings would be bold and influential.
 - Pray that these workers would possess Godly wisdom and a Biblical worldview and that these would impact all decisions that they make.
- Pray for the members of the Georgia House of Representatives and Georgia Senate whose offices are in this building.
 - Pray for your own Senator and Representative by name.
 - Pray for the safety of our Representatives and Senators and their families.
 - Pray that all the Senators and Representatives would provide moral leadership and that they would be Godly mentors, and strongly uphold religious liberties in Georgia.
 - Pray that salvation, Godly wisdom and discernment would abound in this building.
 - Pray that our Senators and Representatives would be true statesmen and not politicians.
 - Pray for godly, principled men and women around the state who will step up and run for office.
 - Pray against any spirit of deception or unrighteousness.

State Capitol Grounds

There are various sculptures outside the Capitol Building and a Cornerstone.

- As you circle the building, pray for all those who enter in and out of this governmental gathering place, that they would experience God's presence and operate in the fear of the Lord. (Psalm 34:9-11)
- Declare that Christ is the Cornerstone of government in Georgia. (Ephesians 2:20)
- Declare that Christ is also the Capstone of our Capitol, declaring His Grace to all who come near.
