Honoring Don Moye

Don Moye is retiring after serving at First Baptist of Vidalia for almost 44 years. He has served in many roles in both FBC and the community, including Minister of Youth, Music, Sunday School and Small Group leader, Executive Pastor, Moderator for the DBA, and in countless other posts. Below are some thoughts from Don.

When I reflect back on these almost 44 years I remember the call of God to come to FBC Vidalia. I was married 10 days to Glenda so we were still on our honeymoon when this barely 24 year old took on the responsibilities of Minister of Music and Youth. One of my life verses was to equip the saints for the work of the service so discipleship was a mandate to me. My call was to be the cup bearer to the king and work to make my pastor successful as an associate. (I have served under only five pastor in all these years). I assumed I would be here for two years completing a three year commitment I had made to Reach Out Ministries to be trained in Youth Evangelism- 1st year, establish a discipleship strategy in a local church -2^{nd} year and then train an intern in that local church- 3^{rd} year. My plan was to head to seminary at South Western which I had put on hold for those three years. God has never released me from FBC Vidalia until just recently to enter retirement and a new chapter in my life.

It takes a unique church to keep a pastor for 43 years and 7 months. FBC is that kind of church. Glenda and I have been blessed. We have had incredible years with wonderful co-workers. All of our seven children and now 20 grandchildren with 21st coming in April have had the stable experience of calling Vidalia home. Our church family and community have been so significant in their upbringing, development and passion for ministry.

It is amazing what we can accomplish for God when we don't care who gets the credit. It is also amazing to see what God will do when we sign a blank contract and let Him fill in the details.

Thank you for your role in encouraging me and allowing me to develop and mature over these years. Hopefully the man I am today is not the same man that moved here in 1974.
