WHAT TO BRING

Bible
Twin-size air mattress or cot to sleep on & bedding
Work boots, work gloves and safety glasses
You may bring your own tool belt with small hand tools if you'd like. (Please be sure any tools you bring are well marked so that you can keep up with them.)
Appropriate work clothes
Towel/shower shoes/toiletries
Mobile phone/camera
Insect repellent/sunscreen
Small flashlight

COST \$10 plus meals during travel to and from Wilmington, NC.

TRANSPORTATION The DBA will provide transportation. Please arrive at the DBA Office at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 11th. We will return to the DBA Office at 3 p.m. on October 14th.

ACCOMMODATIONS For most domestic projects, volunteers are housed at a local church.

TRAINING NO Specialized training required. All training is provided during orientation and is followed up onsite by your Site Team Leader.

BACKGROUND CHECKS All volunteers, ages 18 or older, are required to undergo a background check. Background checks are performed by Samaritan's Purse. Once you have signed up to go, you will receive instructions on how to complete the background check online.

WHO CAN GO Team members must be 14 years of age or older at the time they serve. Team members 14-15 years old need to be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian/grandparent working alongside them at the worksite. Team members 16-17 years of age must be accompanied either by a parent/legal guardian/grandparent or an assigned adult chaperone from their team who is 21 years of age or older. If youth-age volunteers are serving with you, please contact the DBA office to receive a copy of Samaritan's Purse policy, special instructions, and other paperwork specific for youth. Please note that there are additional age restrictions on certain projects.
