Together we are going to pray for every home in our four counties. Each participating church will have a list of households from within their county and will commit to pray, by name, for the spiritual salvation of each household.

A Bible in Every Home

Beginning in January of 2020 our DBA will engage in a media and marketing campaign that will reach our four counties with the opportunity for each home to receive the Word of God. Your DBA will use every media and marketing strategy we can think of and can afford; including commercials, billboards, social media, text messaging, yard signs (and carrier pigeons if we need to); in order to connect with every household that would like to receive a free copy of the Word of God.

Then, for each of our neighbors that request prayer or a Bible, your DBA servants will forward that request to DBA churches so that the church can pray and deliver a Bible, as well as deliver the message of the gospel. Our immediate priority is to <u>begin praying</u> for every home. Many of your DBA churches picked up their A Prayer for Every Home A Bible in Every Home pack at this year's Annual Celebration and many churches have already given a verbal commitment to pray. If you want to get started praying for your neighbors by name but do not have your pack yet, please contact your DBA office.

The immediate need is for saints in every church in the DBA to call out to our Lord in prayer on behalf of our neighbors.

We are also calling all those who are willing and able to join in corporate fasting every Sunday morning. We will come to worship hungry for God and we will repurpose our physical hunger on Sunday mornings so that those cravings will drive us toward God instead of distracting us and driving us away from His presence.
