The Light

We are emerging from our quarantine. We have learned a lot and our eyes have been opened to some things and we need to act on them. Here are some questions to ask:

- How can we continue and increase the spiritual activity which has developed during the quarantine within the home and within the family unit? We do not want the church to compartmentalize and relegate spiritual activity only to certain times during the week and only within the buildings in which we gather.
- How can we continue to deliver the Word to those that are not currently interested in coming inside the building but are interested in community and what the Bible teaches? During the quarantine we have connected with the lost and those who do not have a solid connection to a church family. How can we continue to get the Word out of the walls and into the world?
- How can the church get out of the walls of the building and get in the game of serving our neighbors and our community, especially during times of crisis and difficulty? We are to serve others, especially the vulnerable and marginalized. The presence of the people of God ought to be felt and have impact within the community.

Let's gather our elders, think and discuss these questions and mobilize God's gifted children. Let's nail down a vision, a mission and some actions that we can take through the end of this year and beyond which can win souls, disciple the church and make an eternal kingdom impact.

On another note:

Have you discussed how the gospel addresses the George Floyd incident with your people? The biblical worldview provides the people of God with a lens through which to understand all the issues and we need to know God's heart and mind. We need to discuss these things within the church and make every effort to live what the Bible teaches about love and justice so that we can proclaim to a broken world the wisdom of God. There are any number of scripture passages which address how we ought to respond to our governing authorities and how the gospel informs the manner in which we relate to people

governing authorities and how the gospel informs the manner in which we relate to people who are of a different socio-economic or ethnic background. Just a few examples are Luke 9:46-56; Luke 10:30-37; Ephesians 2:11-22; Acts 10:24-29; Romans 13:1-10; 1 Timothy 2:1-8; James 2:1-9.

Love and justice are two sides of the same coin. We need to understand how they come together at the cross, in the church and in our community.

Please address these issues within our churches and discuss what the Bible teaches and how we can apply what the Bible teaches so that the church can be the light of the world and lead the way. If we are silent about these issues of sin and brokenness which are plaguing the world then we need to consider whether we are only committed to those parts of the Word of God that are palatable and tickle the ears of the people.
