### A Miracle of Multiplication

Jesus and His disciples were somewhere around the Sea of Galilee when thousands of people arrived to hear Him preach. It was late in the day, and the people were getting hungry, so Jesus asked His disciples to find food to feed everyone—all 5,000 people. Unsure what to do next, one of the disciples found a young boy and his packed lunch: five loaves of bread and two fish.
