• January 28-30, 2024 he is reserving the Soccer stadium in Eluru and expecting around 100K ppl will attend over three nights. Every evening from 6-9 with three speakers, sharing the Good News.

Current needs: Prayer for the spread of the gospel and the establishment and strengthening of the church in India. Partnering in the work to provide Bibles, help with the crusade, or give to fund the training of pastors. The BEST way to contribute is to send checks to the DBA office designated "Mission India (Bibles, Crusade, Training)"

The State of India: These pastors have gone without daily provisions to share the gospel. God has given us an opportunity to help our brothers and sisters share the Good News to their people, many which have not heard the Gospel. There is still an open window in some of the districts but many have begun to pull out because of political pressure and hostility. Compassion left 4 or 5 years ago and World Vision left last year because partly of the Foreign Contributions Regulation Act. We have a small window, now, and Andhra Pradesh does not currently have anti-conversion laws. There are over 23 languages and 1600 dialects in India and the 1.4 billion people who are @73% Hindu and @13% Muslim.

Missions around the world! The thought that God would give us the opportunity to participate in the salvation of literally thousands of Muslims and Hindus in the country with the highest concentration of unreached people groups in the entire world, is mind blowing. https://joshuaproject.net/unreached/1
