From the AMS

I thought I would share an abbreviated version of the AMS Report from our recent Executive Committee Meeting.

- Our Lord is faithful and his grace in our fellowship of churches was great in 2025. We engaged in a significant amount of relief work after Helene. The Block Party Trailer, Portable Baptistry, sound system, projector and screen have been utilized many times this year. I'm always particularly blessed to see the portable baptistry being used.
- Several churches have New Pastors:
 Josh Denton at Mount Pisgah; JD
 Mitchell FBC Mount Vernon; Dustin
 Hutto FBCL; Daniel Beasley –
 Ohoopee; Dilan Coursey South
 Thompson. We hope to be a blessing
 to these and all the pastors of the
 DBA.
- One new project is our new podcast for the pastors, Joyful Shepherd. Pastors Luis Gonzalez, Chris Vinson, and Craig Snead are the podcast team. Our Pastor Fellowship Lunch has been an encouragement. The Christian Education Ministry in partnership with BPCU is benefiting some of our pastors as well. I'm glad we have the funds to scholarship our ministers as they pursue their Christian education.
- We began the year with a significant project serving Imago Dei. We helped enclose the garage for more space.
 We served 3 weekends and several churches sent work teams.
- We continue to serve at Wheeler Correctional Facility. Our partners at the Georgia Baptist Mission Board have been a blessing as they have assisted with funding for the ministry at Wheeler.

- We enjoyed an outstanding year at the DBA Children's Camp. Denise Pournelle led brilliantly as always. Griffin Beall stepped into leadership and was excellent in his first year. Jason Corbett served faithfully and improved the camp significantly. We had campers make first time professions of faith and returning campers showed growing maturity. The kids were blessed to have several new young camp counselors. The DBA camp family of counselors and campers are a blessing.
- In 2025 we saw a record number of cakes for Baxley Children's Home – over 600 cakes. We hope for the same this year. We also saw many Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes go out internationally and Christmas backpacks full of blessings go out locally.
- We put a great deal of energy into the SPARK church strengthening conference this year. Over 100 workers from many churches gathered to serve on the campus of BPCU. We hosted over 700 people from over 100 churches. We asked God to use SPARK to ignite a passion for his Kingdom through SPARK.
- Another highlight was the new "DBA Worship Team." Worship leaders from several of our DBA churches came together to lead us singing in the presence of God. The worship team also led us at the DBA Annual Celebration and have blessed many.

- Brian O'Day with the Praetorian
 Project visited us this year. We
 were able to set up meetings
 between Brian several churches.
 These meetings were fruitful as
 more of our DBA churches are
 engaged with planting churches to
 reach our military community
 around the United States.
- Bobby Thompson went to India to partner with Pandu Maddalla and the Victory Baptist Association to preach the gospel to thousands.
 Pandu also came for a week and visited the DBA this year. We are continuing to pray for Pandu and support the advance of the gospel in India.
- We saw positive change in some of our administrative work at the DBA as we made a decision to change insurance carriers. We enjoy the same coverage with a better premium.
- Finally, Pastor BL Horne and Southside Baptist in McRae was received by unanimous vote into the DBA at the October Executive Committee Meeting. Southside is a mission minded church. They are already faithfully partnering with you by praying, giving, going and sending. We are blessed to have them in our DBA family and we thank God for them.

May 2026 be a year of kingdom advance, great fellowship, and worship in the churches of the DBA.

Christian Education

Brewton-Parker Christian University and the DBA are partnering to offer Christian Education courses to our community.

Here are a few important facts:

- The courses are offered in-person.
- The courses focus on biblical and theological training as well as ministry.

Who Was Lottie Moon?

Born Charlotte Digges Moon, December 12, 1840, in Albemarle County, Virginia. Lottie rebelled against Christianity until she college. in was December 1858, she dedicated her life to Christ and was baptized at First Baptist Church, Charlottesville, Virginia.

Lottie attended Albemarle Female Institute, female counterpart to the University of Virginia. In 1861, she was one of the first women in the South to receive a master's degree. She stayed close to home during the Civil War but eventually taught school in Kentucky, Georgia and Virginia.

Lottie served 39 years as a missionary, mostly in China's Shantung province. She taught in a girls' school and often made trips into China's interior to share the good news with women and girls.

Lottie Moon was passionate about people knowing Christ. She didn't hesitate to speak her mind. Today's China is a world of rapid change. It's home to 1.4 billion individuals – one-fifth of the world's population. Village dwellers flock to trendy megacities with exploding populations. And China holds its own in the world's economy. It's very different from the vast farmland Lottie Moon entered in the 1800s. But one thing hasn't changed: China's need for a Savior.


