From the AMS:

1. Fuel Prayers with Specific Information

- It is difficult to pray fervently for what you do not know. Often, church members want to pray but don't know what to pray for beyond "bless the missionaries." You must bridge the gap between the field and the pew.
- Curate "Fresh" Requests: Avoid recycling the same general requests for months. Appoint a "Missions Champion" to communicate directly with your missionaries or partner organizations monthly to get current praises and prayer needs (e.g., "Pray for the visa appointment on Tuesday" rather than just "Pray for legal issues").
- Use Visual Storytelling: People connect with faces and stories. Instead of just listing a name in a bulletin, share a 60-second video clip from a missionary or display a photo of the specific people group they are trying to reach.
- The "Unreached" Focus: Use resources like International Mission Board, Operation World, or the Joshua Project to highlight a different unreached people group or nation each week, providing specific cultural context and spiritual hurdles to pray for.

2. Integrate Missions into the "Main Stage"

- If prayer for missions is relegated only to a small Wednesday night group or a basement committee, the congregation will implicitly learn that it is not a priority. It must be visible in the primary corporate gathering.
- The 3-Minute Window: Dedicate three minutes in the Sunday service specifically for missions prayer. This shouldn't just be an announcement; have a lay leader or pastor briefly explain a specific need and then lead the whole room in prayer right then and there.
- Liturgical Integration: Weave missions into the fabric of the service. Choose worship songs that highlight God's heart for the nations and consistently highlight the missional focus of the gospel through the sermon.

Helpful Hints

Tips for becoming a Mission Praying Church



- Pre-Service Loops: Use the time before the service starts (when slides are looping) to display maps, photos of missionaries, and short, bulleted prayer points.

3. Make Prayer Tangible and Accessible

- To help members carry the burden of prayer home with them, give them physical or digital tools that serve as reminders throughout the week.
- "Adopt" a Missionary/Zone: Small groups or Sunday School classes can "adopt" a specific missionary family. This creates a personal relationship where the group feels a sense of ownership and responsibility to pray for "their" family.
- Physical Reminders: Create prayer cards, bookmarks, or refrigerator magnets with missionary photos and constant prayer needs. Distribute "Prayer Passports" for children to stamp as they pray for different countries.
- Tech-Enabled Prayer: Utilize your church app or email list to send out "Urgent Prayer Alerts." When a missionary sends a text about a crisis, push that notification to your prayer team immediately. This creates a sense of real-time

To transform a congregation into a "praying church" regarding missions, the key is to move from general, vague prayers to specific, informed intercession. When people know the details, they pray with more passion and consistency.

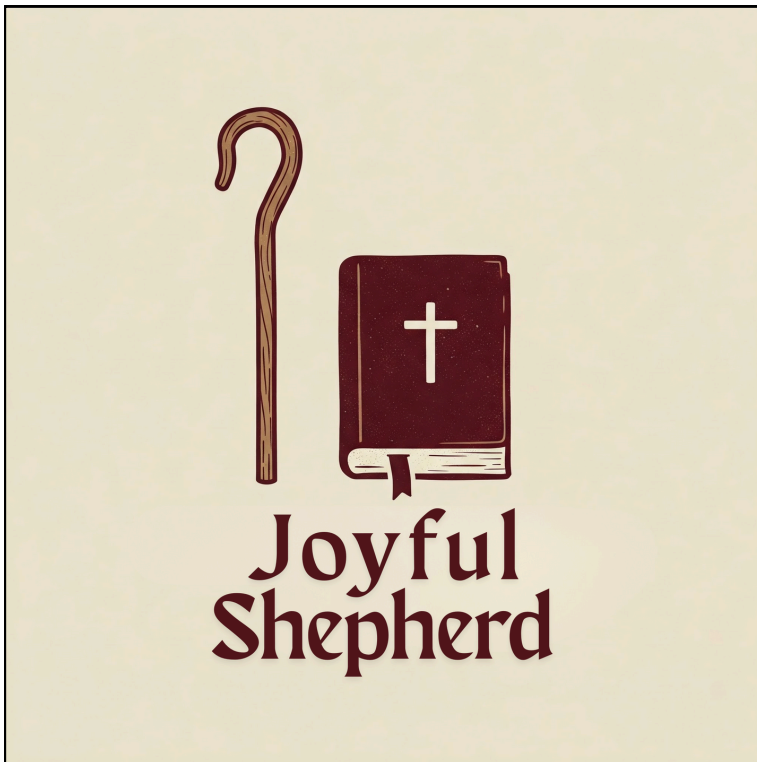
