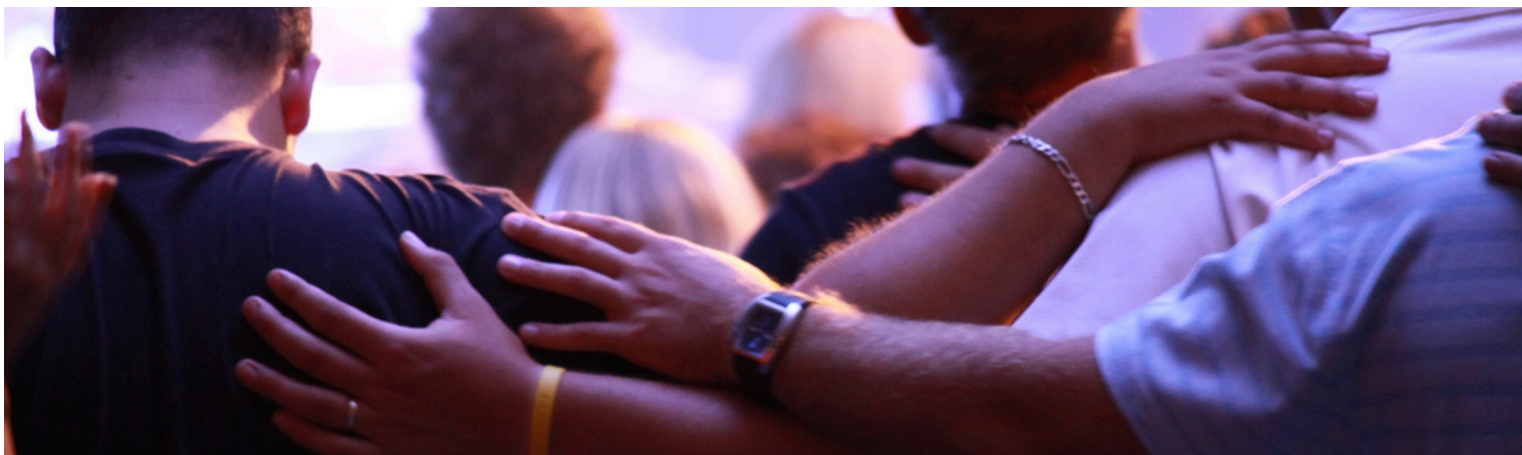

A handwritten note or a brief, welcoming phone call from pastoral leadership can communicate profound care. By intentionally reaching out, we extend the hospitality of Christ, demonstrating our desire to come alongside them in their spiritual journey rather than simply adding to our weekly attendance.

**Honoring Our Faithful Co-Laborers** The vital logistics of weekly ministry rely heavily on the dedication of our church members. Take a moment this month to intentionally recognize those who serve faithfully behind the scenes—whether they are teaching children, overseeing audio-visual needs, or preparing the sanctuary. A culture of sincere appreciation not only strengthens our shared mission but also dignifies the valuable contributions of every individual serving the body of Christ.

## From the AMS:

Death is one of the most profound realities we navigate alongside our congregations in this life. It was never the intended state of humankind to die and be separated from God forever.

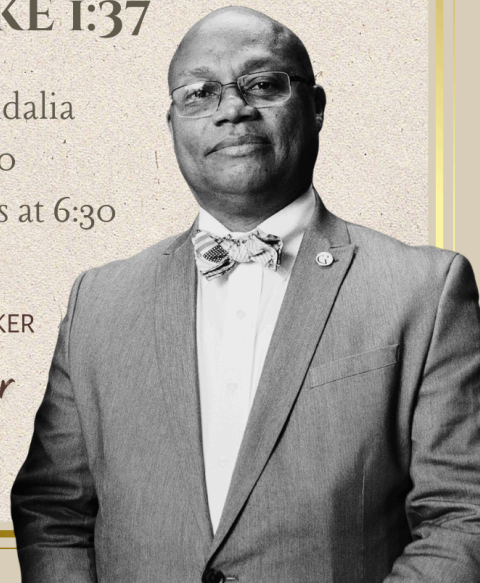

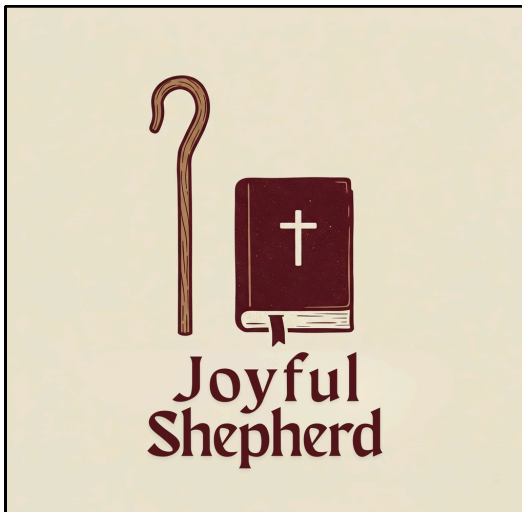
